The United Church of Canada's **Faithful Footprints** program offers inspiration, tools, and grants to help its communities of faith reduce their energy and carbon footprint. Delivered by **Faith & the Common Good**, the program provides up to **\$30,000** in grants towards energy conservation and renewable energy projects (conditions apply). To date, the program has engaged over **300+** congregations, camps, and buildings across the country.

Faithful Footprints aligns with The United Church of Canada's Strategic Objective, <u>Deepen Integrity: Living Climate</u>

<u>Commitments</u>, supports the climate pillar, <u>Putting Our House in Order</u>, and is one initiative toward achieving the church's national goal of reducing carbon emissions <u>80% by 2030</u>.

Project Examples

- The insulation of attic or walls
- Major air sealing (caulking and weatherstripping)
- Converting lights to LEDs
- Installation of energy efficiency heating and cooling system
- Upgrading of windows
- Replacement of appliances with new Energy Star appliances
- Installation of solar system
